

RESOLUTION 2000-01

of the

ARKANSAS SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ARKANSAS WATER, WASTE DISPOSAL AND POLLUTION ABATEMENT FACILITIES GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROGRAM FOR THE 1999-2001 BIENNIUM; AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE PLAN TO THE GOVERNOR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that there is a need for approximately two (2) billion dollars in capital needs for water, waste disposal, and pollution abatement projects in Arkansas within the next five (5) years;

WHEREAS, available sources of funding will not supply necessary funds to meet this need;

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined that there are numerous projects that could benefit from being funded by the Arkansas Water, Waste Disposal and Pollution Abatement Facilities General Obligation Bond Program (the "Program");

WHEREAS, as a condition of issuing bonds under the Program, the Commission must develop and submit a plan of work to the Governor for his review and approval.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION,

Section 1. The Arkansas Water, Waste Disposal and Pollution Abatement Facilities General Obligation Bond Program Plan of Work for the 1999-2001 Biennium dated February 24, 2000 is hereby approved and adopted by the Commission as required by the Act.

Section 2. The Commission Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to submit the Plan of Work to the Governor for his review and approval.
