A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING DAVID HILLMAN, OF ARKANSAS COUNTY FOR HIS SERVICE ON THE COMMISSION AND HIS OTHER CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CONSERVATION OF ARKANSAS' SOIL AND WATER RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman served Arkansas as a member of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission from 1988 to 2002 and was chairman of the Commission for the years of 1994 and 2001;

WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman was appointed to the Arkansas County Conservation District in 1987 and continues to serve as conservation district director providing leadership in the conservation and development of the soil and water resources within the district;

WHEREAS, Mr. Hillman offered his leadership as president of the Arkansas Farm Bureau Federation from 2000 to present and as vice president of the Federation. Mr. Hillman has also served as the state secretary/treasurer and has been on the state organization for fifteen years;
