Instructions for reporting egg/egg product sales in Arkansas:

Arkansas law requires fees be paid on all eggs processed and/or sold in Arkansas for the purpose of financing the administration, inspection, and promotion of eggs. An annual permit fee in the amount of \$60.00, to be due at the time of issuance or renewal (July 1) of each year in addition to inspection fees paid each month.

All shell egg packers, egg products plants, distributors and/or wholesalers selling graded eggs into the state of Arkansas will be responsible for the following fees.

1. All graded eggs or egg products sold directly into Arkansas to other than an Arkansas permitted packer will report and pay six (6) cents per 30 dozen case.
2. Egg Products:
 - a. Liquid or frozen egg products will be reported and fees paid at a rate of six (6) cents per case based on total pounds of product.
36 pounds of frozen or liquid egg product is equivalent to 1-case/30 dozen shell eggs.
Example: 5,000 lbs. \div 36 = 139 cases \times .06 ϕ = \$8.34
 - b. Dried egg product will be reported and fees paid at a rate of 6 cents per case based on total pounds of product.
9 pounds of dried egg is equivalent to 1 case/30 dozen shell eggs.
Example: 5,000 lbs. \div 9 = 556 cases \times .06 ϕ = \$33.36
 - c. Boiled eggs will be reported and fees paid at a rate of 6 cents per case based on total pounds of product.
50 pounds of boiled eggs is equivalent to 1 case/30 dozen shell eggs.
Example: 5000 lbs \div 50 = 100 cases \times .06 ϕ = \$6.00
 - d. Diced egg product will be reported and fees paid at a rate of 6 cents per case based on total pounds of product. 50 pounds of product.
50 pounds of diced egg is equivalent to 1 case/30 dozen shell eggs.
Example: 5, 000 \div 50 = 100 cases \times .06 ϕ = \$6.00
