The Arkansas Bureau of Standards is aware some retail motor fuel dispensers can not display price requirements of the *Liquid-Measuring Devices Code* as published in the 2016 edition of the *National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Handbook 44*. Specifically, **Section S.1.6.1. Indication of Delivery, Section S.1.6.4.1. Unit Price, and Section S.1.6.5. Money-Value Computations.**

The Arkansas Bureau of Standards is temporarily permitting owners/operators, with dispensers that can not meet the above stated requirements, to post a unit price at $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon increments and double the total sale price. To utilize this pricing practice, the following conditions must be met:

1. The owner/operator must place a sign on each affected dispenser clearly stating the posted price per gallon and the total indicated sale is $\frac{1}{2}$ price and will be doubled.
2. The sign must be conspicuously placed on each face of the dispenser.
3. The font on the sign should be no less than $\frac{3}{4}$ " in height.
