Instructions for the Arkansas Application for Registration of Pesticides (DP-21 (Rev. 10/19)) form

This form is for Registration of products that are not listed on the DP-21 Renewal:

1. **Indicate calendar year ending December 31.**
2. **“Product ID Number” column:** Do Not Write In This Space!
3. **“Complete Brand and Name of Pesticide” column:** Indicate complete Brand and name of pesticide.

Registrants desiring to discontinue a product registration should be aware that Arkansas requires a two-year discontinuance. A “Out of the Channels of Trade” letter stating there is no product within the channels of trade in lieu of the discontinuance period is acceptable. The registrant should be certain that there is, in fact, no product within the channels of trade before submitting such a letter. Arkansas State Law holds the registrant responsible for any unregistered product found within the channels of trade.

Please indicate “D-1” for first year discontinuance or “D-2” for second year discontinuance or “OTC” for out of channels of trade next to the product name.

4. **“APD Fee Exempt” column:** Please indicate “Y” if a product is exempt from paying the APD fee or “N” if a product is not exempt and is required to pay the APD fee.

Arkansas requires a \$50.00 Abandoned Pesticide Disposal (APD) Fee for some products. This disposal fee does not apply to 1) Sanitizers and Disinfectants, 2) Aerosol products which are not labeled for agricultural use, 3) Insect repellants which are labeled for use on the human body or clothing, 4) Silica gels and other non-volatile ready-to-use paste, foam or gel formulations of insecticidal baits, 5) Non-volatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations, 6) Insecticidal flea and tick collars and spot-on flea treatments for dogs and cats, and 7) Insecticidal cattle ear tags. **Registrants** must indicate on the Application for Registration of Pesticides (DP-21 (Rev. 9/20)) that their product is exempt under this column in order to avoid paying the APD Fee. Registrants who do not indicate an exemption under this column are expected to pay the \$50.00 APD Fee in addition to the full \$250.00 registration fee.

5. **“EPA Registration Number” column:** Indicate complete EPA Registration Number
6. **“Category” column:** Do Not Write In This Space!
7. **“Total Fee enclosed”:** Please indicate the total amount of fees.

8. **“Company Name, mailing address, City and State, Signature, Printed Name, Date of Application, Telephone Number and Email”:** Please complete for each field accordingly.
9. **“Check to Receive Certificate by Email”:** To receive electronic correspondences please check the box. Registration documents will be emailed in lieu of a mailed hard copy.

Submit the completed DP-21 (Rev. 9/20) to the PLANT INDUSTRIES, PESTICIDE SECTION, 1 NATURAL RESOURCES DRIVE, LITTLE ROCK, AR 72205 with the following required documentation:

- Check payable to State Plant Board for the total amount of fees
- PDF format of a complete product label. Labels may be submitted on a CD, emailed to Pesticide.registration@arkansas.gov or uploaded to Accepted Labels State Tracking and Repository (ALSTAR) database.
- Out of channels of trade letter if applicable.
