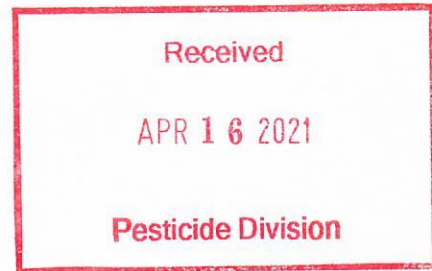


Arkansas State Plant Board,
