PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME - GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Agriculture is Arkansas' largest industry and contributes over \$20.9 billion to our state's economy each year;

WHEREAS: Egg production ranks among Arkansas' top 5 agricultural commodities in cash receipts, valued at \$693 million annually;

WHEREAS: Arkansas produces more than 1.59 billion shell eggs annually and ranks 8th in the nation for egg production and 1st in the nation for egg exports;

WHEREAS: Arkansas has seven egg processing facilities in Central and Northwest Arkansas committed to providing premium eggs and egg products;

WHEREAS: The Arkansas Department of Agriculture's Livestock and Poultry Division has 11 shell egg inspectors that provide more than 14,000 man-hours each year to ensure the highest egg quality standards are met at processing facilities, restaurants, farmers markets, retail stores, and other points of sale;


WHEREAS: The Arkansas Department of Agriculture's Livestock and Poultry Division issues more than 252 egg handling permits for the sale and distribution of eggs within the State of Arkansas to entities meeting the United States Department of Agriculture's health, safety, and quality standards; and

WHEREAS: Eggs are a good source of high-quality protein and other nutrients including vitamin D, phosphorus, riboflavin, and selenium.
